


IL SALUTO DEL PRESIDENTE FIR

The World Rugby U20 Championship represents for sure the highest international level for players at the edge of their development path, a final step before testing themselves as men and athletes in senior rugby, deciding whether to make it a profession and not only a passion.

Thousands of young players aged between 18 and 20 dream of taking part to this competition every year, but only 30 of them make it real: I congratulate them on behalf of the Italian Rugby Federation, for an achievement reached with effort, commitment and seriousness, experiencing day by day that talent alone is not enough at this level.

Italy has the privilege of playing in the Championship, having earned the right to remain in the group of the 12 best teams in the world in 2023. The goal is first of all to confirm this opportunity also in 2024, without precluding what may possibly come along the way until the last day, coming from a very positive Six Nations but aware that every match of the Tournament will be very tough, having to face opponents of the caliber of Ireland, Australia and Georgia in Pool B.

The renewed technical staff finds in Roberto Santamaria a reliable, competent and highly motivated head-coach. The



additions of Andrea Marcato and Alessandro Lodi complete a young coaching team with great potential, ready to compete at the highest possible standard.

To our guys my suggestion is to face the competition with seriousness, but also with the

lightness that is still a right for them at this age: they play the most beautiful sport in the world, wearing their country's jersey, being able to compete with other players driven by the same motivations, proud to defend their flag and they people. It will be three intense weeks, full of emotions and both positive and negative moments, an unforgettable experience that will remain forever in their eyes and in their hearts, hopefully making them better players, but certainly better men.

My warmest greetings and thanks to World Rugby, the South African Government and the Organizing Committee for the work that awaits them starting from June 29th, in the certainty that what we saw in 2023 will be even better this year.

Finally, a strong hug to Italy, as a father would do before an important trial in the life of his children.
